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# Implementation of Discussion Method in Efforts to Improve Student Learning Outcomes in Islamic Education Learning at SMA Negeri 2 Padang

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**Abstract:** This study aims to improve student learning outcomes in Islamic religious education learning by using the discussion method. This study is a classroom action research that uses four steps, namely planning, action, observation and reflection. The subjects of this study were high school students. The data for this study were obtained by test and observation techniques. Tests are used to measure learning outcomes and observations are used to analyze teacher and student learning activities. The data analysis technique used in this study is descriptive statistics by comparing the results obtained with indicators of research success. The results of the study indicate that the discussion method can improve student learning outcomes in Islamic religious education learning. This can be seen from the increase in the percentage of student learning completion in each cycle with details of the pre-cycle 48.71%, the first cycle 66.39% and in the second cycle it increased to 89.66%. Thus, the use of the discussion method can be used as an alternative to improve student learning outcomes in Islamic religious education learning.

Islamic Religious Education (PAI) is one of the subjects that has a strategic role in shaping students' character and personality. One of the main factors that causes low PAI learning outcomes is the lack of student involvement in the learning process.

Through this study, the researcher wants to find out the extent to which the application of the discussion method can affect student learning outcomes in PAI subjects, and whether this method can be a solution to improve the quality of learning in class XI F 6 SMAN 2 Padang. Thus, this research is expected to make a positive contribution in developing more effective learning methods that are in accordance with the needs of students.

#### **METHODS**

This research is a Classroom Action Research that aims to improve and improve the quality of learning in the classroom through a series of actions designed by teachers as researchers. PTK is carried out directly in the classroom by involving students as research subjects. This research process consists of several cycles that include the stages of planning, implementation, observation, and reflection to evaluate. The effectiveness of the measures implemented. In this study, the discussion method is applied in Islamic Religious Education learning in class XI F 6 SMAN 2 Padang with the hope of increasing student involvement and learning outcomes.

This study involves two main variables, namely the independent variable in the form of the application of the discussion method and the bound variable in the form of student learning outcomes in PAI subjects. The discussion method includes activities such as group discussions, questions and answers, and sharing opinions that aim to improve student understanding. Student learning outcomes are measured based on test scores and observations of student involvement in learning. The relationship between these two variables was analyzed to determine the influence of discussion methods on student learning outcomes.

The population in this study is all students of class XI F 6 totaling 30 people. The data collected consisted of quantitative and qualitative data. Quantitative data were obtained through pre-test and post-test tests to measure the improvement of student learning outcomes, while qualitative data was collected through observation during the discussion process to understand the level of student participation and learning dynamics. The data sources come from students and their learning outcomes, which are then analyzed using various techniques such as tests, observations, and documentation.

Data analysis techniques include quantitative descriptive analysis to measure the difference in pre-test and post-test scores and qualitative analysis to understand student interaction during discussions. Hypothesis testing was carried out using a t-test to determine the effectiveness of the discussion method, as well as data triangulation to increase the validity of the findings. The results of the study are expected to provide an overview of the effectiveness of discussion methods in improving student learning outcomes and provide recommendations for future learning improvements.

#### **RESULTS**

The researcher made initial observations on islamic religious education learning in class XI F 6 SMAN 2 Padang and found that 55% of students obtained a score below the KKM set at 85, with a monotonous learning atmosphere due to the dominance of the lecture method so that student participation was limited. To overcome this, the group discussion method is applied to improve student interaction and understanding. Action planning includes the formation of heterogeneous groups, the preparation of materials, the preparation of Group Worksheets (LKK), the division of roles, assessment, and awarding. The implementation of the action is carried out in two cycles, with the first cycle including the planning, implementation, observation, and reflection stages. The results of the first cycle showed an increase in student participation and an average score increase of about 16-17 points, indicating that this method had a positive impact on student comprehension.

The implementation of cycle I showed that the group discussion method succeeded in increasing student activity in learning, where students who were previously passive began to be more enthusiastic and confident in expressing their opinions. This discussion also had a positive impact on the understanding of the material, as evidenced by the increase in test scores after the activity, as students could learn from each other in groups. However, some challenges are still faced, such as students who lack confidence and are less active in discussions, so further efforts are needed to create a more inclusive atmosphere and encourage the participation of all students.
